1. **Non-refundable Application Fee**

2. **Grades K-7 Non-refundable Tuition and Fees**

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6. Scholarships and Grants****

- a. Active Parishioner St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Student Aid - To qualify, a family must be a registered member of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, Santa Maria Del Mar, or another diocesan parish, attend weekly Sunday Mass as a family, and contribute a minimum of \$520 per year through regular, weekly donations to the home parish, which is confirmed through the parish business office. ***It is available only to students in grades K to 8.*** Failure to meet scholarship requirements in a review of scholarship eligibility may lead to loss of current and/or future Parishioner Scholarship funds. Deadline to apply is May 15, 2026. Apply through FACTS Grant and Aid and complete parishioner form, obtained through school office.

- b. Step Up for Students Scholarships - Amount varies
St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic School accepts the Florida Tax Credit (FTC), Family Empowerment (FES-EO), and FES-UA (on a case by case basis as we confirm whether we can meet the student's needs). All families qualify for grades K-8 and are encouraged to apply at www.stepupforstudents.org. Please contact the school office at 386-445-2411 for further information about scholarships.

******Families who receive the school choice scholarships are responsible for the payment of the difference between full tuition and scholarship received.** This should be done through a payment plan with FACTS. Families can receive only **one** scholarship. Step Up payments to the school are not refundable if a student is withdrawn.

- c. SEAS Tuition Assistance Grant - **Limited** tuition assistance is available for non-parishioner families for K-8 who need additional assistance. To apply, please visit <http://online.factsmgt.com/SignIn.aspx>.



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7. **Additional Financial and Family Obligations**

- a. Tuition and fees are ***non-refundable***.
- b. Applications and payment of application fee do not guarantee admission. ***All application fees are non-refundable.***
- c. The Diocese of St. Augustine, which includes St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic School, ***does not accept religious exemptions for vaccines.***
- d. Families must register for and keep an active FACTS account for payments.
- e. Families are required to pay the difference between scholarship amount received and tuition balance. Pre-paid tuition is not refundable.
- f. It is the responsibility of the family to ensure their children are wearing current, well-fitting, proper, required school uniforms from Flynn O'Hara each year.
- g. It is mandatory for each family to sell a minimum of two boxes of chocolate or pay a fee directly to the school. Selling chocolate is not part of volunteer hours.
- h. Each family is asked to contribute ten (10) hours of volunteer service by working at school events. If a family is not able to volunteer, they may pay \$200 directly to the school.
- i. Families are required to participate in the two major fundraisers (as scheduled), one to be held in the fall and one in the spring. Fundraising events are planned to help us meet our budgetary parameters.
- j. SEAS School no longer accepts credit cards for payments.
- k. St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic School relies on families' timely payments to meet our budget parameters. We thank you for ensuring that your tuition, fees, and other payments are up to date.
