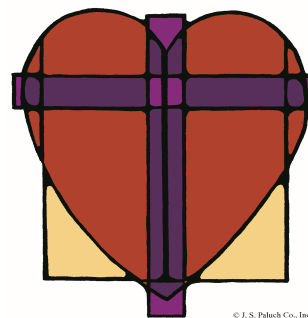

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

When I first came here to Saint Mary Immaculate, of course there were a number of projects that needed to be done. We would love to have accomplished them all by now, but resources and prudence told us we couldn't do them right away. You know what some of them are: repaving the parking lot, fixing the roof in the Commons, and that's just the start. Over time, I've also noticed the church worship space could use some serious attention. We were able to re-carpet the church and narthex, thanks to the generosity of Patrick and Kathryn O'Donnell. But we really need to paint the church, since, as far as I can tell, it hasn't been painted since it was built. The pews also need to be refinished and repaired, and Mary and Joseph deserve a better location than where they are. The sound system also needs to be modernized, as it could go out on us soon, and we could use more lighting in the church, especially for evening Masses and night activities. We also want to have a safer space for the choir.

So much to do! Can we do it all soon? I don't know. But I am hoping we can do a good portion of the projects. Over the coming months, you will be hearing about a readiness assessment project, which will help us to determine what we can accomplish. I'd like everyone to be a part of that in some way.

In order to plan with prudence, we have retained the services of Lorraine Klemz Consulting, Inc. to assist us this fall with that readiness assessment. There are four methodologies that will be utilized to garner parishioner sentiments regarding the future of Saint Mary Immaculate, including personal interviews, vision group sessions, listening sessions and a parish survey. All of these will take place this coming September and October.

Every family will have a chance to participate in at least one of these four ways to ensure that every voice is heard. From this process, plans will be formed and finalized to address our parish needs.

For those of you who have not met Lorraine, I would like to share some of her background and qualifications. Since 1999, Lorraine has managed and directed Capital Campaigns with goals ranging from \$1 million to \$15 million. She recently completed Capital Campaigns with Holy Family Parish in Shorewood and Immaculate Conception Parish in Elmhurst. Lorraine has worked with me most recently on the SMIP annual offertory appeal in 2018, and has helped train our development staff. In 2017, Lorraine received the Damen Award from Loyola University of Chicago for raising more than \$100,000,000 for Catholic organizations in the Chicagoland area.

I thank you in advance for your thoughtful and prayerful participation in this process.

The Word from Fr. Pat / La Palabra del Padre Pat

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo:

Cuando vine por primera vez a Santa María Inmaculada, por supuesto, había varios proyectos que debían realizarse. Me hubiera gustado que para estas alturas ya hubiéramos terminado todos, sin embargo los recursos y la prudencia me dijeron que no podíamos hacerlos de inmediato. Usted sabe lo que algunos de ellos son: repavimentar el estacionamiento, arreglar el techo en el área de la recepción y eso es solo el comienzo. Con el tiempo, también he notado que el espacio de adoración de la iglesia podría requerir cierta atención. Pudimos cambiar la alfombra en la iglesia y el nártex, gracias a la generosidad de Patrick y Kathryn O'Donnell. Sin embargo, realmente necesitamos pintar la iglesia, ya que, por lo que puedo decir, no ha sido pintada desde que fue construida. Las bancas también deben ser reparadas, y las estatuas de María y José merecen una mejor ubicación que donde están. El sistema de sonido también debe modernizarse, ya que podría descomponerse pronto, y podríamos usar más iluminación en la iglesia, especialmente para las misas y las actividades nocturnas. También queremos tener un espacio más seguro para el coro.

¡Mucho que hacer! ¿Podemos hacerlo todo pronto? No lo sé. Pero espero que podamos hacer una buena parte de los proyectos. Durante los próximos meses, escuchará sobre un proyecto de evaluación de la preparación, que nos ayudará a determinar qué podemos lograr. Me gustaría que todos sean parte de eso de alguna manera.

Para planificar con prudencia, hemos contratado los servicios de Lorraine Klemz Consulting, Inc. para ayudarnos este otoño con esa evaluación de preparación. Hay cuatro metodologías que se utilizarán para reunir los sentimientos de los feligreses con respecto al futuro de Santa María Inmaculada, que incluyen entrevistas personales, sesiones de grupos de visión, sesiones de escucha y una encuesta parroquial. Todo esto tendrá lugar los próximos meses de septiembre y octubre.

Cada familia tendrá la oportunidad de participar en al menos una de estas cuatro formas para asegurar que cada voz sea escuchada. A partir de este proceso, se formarán y finalizarán planes para abordar las necesidades de nuestra parroquia.

Para aquellos de ustedes que no han conocido a Lorraine, me gustaría compartir algunos de sus antecedentes y cualificaciones. Desde 1999, Lorraine ha administrado y dirigido Campañas de Capital con metas que van desde \$ 1 millón hasta \$ 15 millones. Recientemente completó Campañas de Capital con Holy Family Parish en Shorewood y Immaculate Conception Parish en Elmhurst. Lorraine ha trabajado conmigo más recientemente en el llamamiento de ofrenda anual de SMIP en 2018, y ha ayudado a capacitar a nuestro personal de desarrollo. En 2017, Lorraine recibió el Premio Damen de la Universidad Loyola de Chicago por recaudar más de \$ 100,000,000 para organizaciones católicas en el área de Chicago.

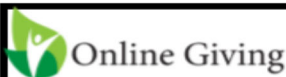

- 3) **Automatic Withdrawal Program** is controlled by the Parish Office. You select the amount and offertory collections you wish to give to and amounts are deducted from your checking or savings account on the 5th and/or 20th of each month. Simply notify the Parish Office if you need to make a change.

Gifts of Appreciated Securities

Donating appreciated securities offers considerable tax advantages. Donors can deduct the current market value of a stock donation on the date of the gift and do not have to recognize the income from any related appreciation of the securities. To make a stock donation, instruct your broker to transfer the shares you wish to contribute to the Diocese of Joliet's account with Stofan, Agazzi and Co., Inc. Your broker will need to know the Diocese's DTC #0141 and the Diocesan Account #2496-9663. Donors are strongly encouraged to notify the diocese by calling 815-221-6192 on or around the date of such a gift and provide your name, the company name of the stock and the number of shares to be transferred so that the donation can be quickly processed and properly credited to St. Mary Immaculate Parish.

IRA Charitable Rollover

For donors 70-1/2 or older, a charitable gift of up to \$100,000 (\$200,000 for married couples) can be made from your IRA account tax free for federal income tax purposes. The gift must come from a traditional or Roth IRA and be transferred directly from your IRA to St. Mary Immaculate Parish in order to be tax-free. The amount donated will count toward your minimum required distribution and does not increase your taxable income.

Bequest Intentions

Donors who wish to leave some portion of their estate to support St. Mary Immaculate Parish are encouraged to have their attorney or estate planning professional include specific language in their will that identifies the charitable beneficiary as St. Mary Immaculate Parish. Donors choosing this philanthropic option are encouraged to notify the Pastor or the business office of their intention so that their generosity may be acknowledged.

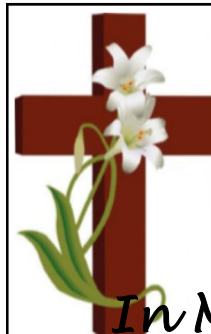

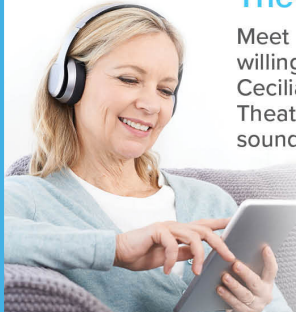

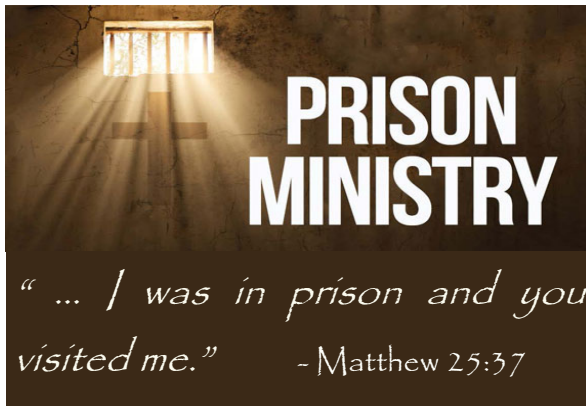
