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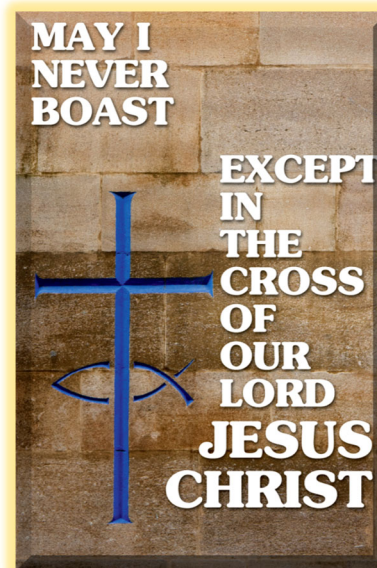

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This coming Thursday, July 11, is the feast of Saint Benedict. Saint Benedict began his religious life seeking to be a hermit. But that didn't last long. Even though he moved to a cave in the mountains, men continued to come to him seeking to live a religious life. Eventually, he began to form one of the most famous monasteries in the world, Monte Cassino.

What is so striking about Saint Benedict's monasticism is found in his famous *Rule*. The *Rule* prescribed a life of liturgical prayer, study, manual labor and living together in community under a common father, known as an abbot. Benedictines take vows of poverty, chastity, obedience and stability (vowing to remain in their abbey for their entire lives). One of the hallmarks of their charism is the virtue of hospitality.

This virtue is expressed in Chapter 53 of the *Rule* which says, "Let all guests be received as Christ." This is pictured in the plaque shown above, which adorns the wall of the guest dining room at Saint Procopius Abbey in Lisle. If you've had any contact with Benedictines at all, perhaps you've received this hospitality; I know I have when I have stayed with them for retreats and times of reflection.

But here's the takeaway. That little virtue is one that we can practice too, each in our own way. What would happen if we treated every person that came to us as Christ? Would our jobs be more satisfying? Would our families be strengthened? Would our parish be more welcoming? Would our lives be more peaceful and would we be happier? We tend to look for all sorts of artificial happiness; what would it be like if we instead made happiness happen by treating every person we met as Christ?

Our world needs Christ more than ever. If we just assume that each person brings us the presence of Christ in some way, and we treat them accordingly, I think we might be more aware of Christ's presence and see that he is with us more often than we think.

Let all guests be received as Christ.

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo:

Este próximo jueves, 11 de julio, es la fiesta de San Benito. San Benito comenzó su vida religiosa buscando ser un ermitaño. Pero eso no duró mucho. A pesar de que se mudó a una cueva en las montañas, los hombres siguieron yendo a él buscando vivir una vida religiosa. Con el tiempo, comenzó a formar uno de los monasterios más famosos del mundo, Monte Cassino.

Lo que sorprende del ascetismo de San Benito se encuentra en su famosa Regla. La Regla establecía una vida de oración litúrgica, estudio, trabajo manual y convivencia en comunidad bajo un padre común, conocido como abad. Los benedictinos hacen votos de pobreza, castidad, obediencia y estabilidad (jurando permanecer en su abadía durante toda su vida). Una de las características de su carisma es la virtud de la hospitalidad.

Esta virtud se expresa en el Capítulo 53 de la Regla que dice: "Que todos los invitados sean recibidos como Cristo". Esto se muestra en la placa que se muestra arriba, que adorna la pared del comedor de invitados en la Abadía de San Procopio en Lisle. Si ha tenido algún contacto con los benedictinos, tal vez haya recibido esta hospitalidad; yo la he recibido cuando me he quedado con ellos para retiros y tiempos de reflexión.

Sin embargo, esta es la moraleja: Esa pequeña virtud es una que podemos practicar también, cada uno a nuestra manera. ¿Qué pasaría si tratamos a cada persona que viene a nosotros como a Cristo? ¿Serían nuestros trabajos más satisfactorios? ¿Se fortalecerían nuestras familias? ¿Sería nuestra parroquia más acogedora? ¿Serían nuestras vidas más pacíficas y seríamos más felices? Tendemos a buscar todo tipo de felicidad artificial; ¿Cómo sería si creáramos nosotros mismos la felicidad al tratar a cada persona que conocemos como al mismo Cristo?

Nuestro mundo necesita a Cristo más que nunca. Si asumimos que cada persona nos trae la presencia de Cristo de alguna manera, y los tratamos acorde a esto, creo que podríamos estar más conscientes de la presencia de Cristo y ver que él está con nosotros más a menudo de lo que pensamos.

Que todos los invitados sean recibidos como Cristo.

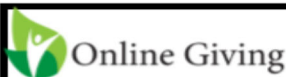

Ways to Give to St. Mary Immaculate Parish

St Mary Immaculate Parish appreciates the generosity of its families. Beside the standard envelopes that could be mailed to you, we provide you three (3) different ways you can sign up to give automatically.

- 1) **Online Giving** program through Our Sunday Visitor. You set your own login and password and control what offertory collections you wish to contribute to and when. (box on the lower right details all our standard collections) You also have the ability to log-in anytime and change the dollar amount and dates.

- 2) **Credit Card Authorization Program** is controlled by the Parish Office. You select the amount and offertory collections you wish to give to and amounts are charged to your credit card on the 5th and/or 20th of each month. Simply notify the Parish Office if you need to make a change.
- 3) **Automatic Withdrawal Program** is controlled by the Parish Office. You select the amount and offertory collections you wish to give to and amounts are deducted from your checking or savings account on the 5th and/or 20th of each month. Simply notify the Parish Office if you need to make a change.

These electronic giving options have been designed to help parishioners consistently support the offertory. If you choose option 2 or 3, please return this form to the parish office via the collection basket, mail or email.

Gifts of Appreciated Securities

Donating appreciated securities offers considerable tax advantages. Donors can deduct the current market value of a stock donation on the date of the gift and do not have to recognize the income from any related appreciation of the securities. To make a stock donation, instruct your broker to transfer the shares you wish to contribute to the Diocese of Joliet's account with Stofan, Agazzi and Co., Inc. Your broker will need to know the Diocese's DTC #0141 and the Diocesan Account #2496-9663. Donors are strongly encouraged to notify the diocese by calling 815-221-6192 on or around the date of such a gift and provide your name, the company name of the stock and the number of shares to be transferred so that the donation can be quickly processed and properly credited to St. Mary Immaculate Parish.

IRA Charitable Rollover

For donors 70-1/2 or older, a charitable gift of up to \$100,000 (\$200,000 for married couples) can be made from your IRA account tax free for federal income tax purposes. The gift must come from a traditional or Roth IRA and be transferred directly from your IRA to St. Mary Immaculate Parish in order to be tax-free. The amount donated will count toward your minimum required distribution and does not increase your taxable income.

Bequest Intentions

Donors who wish to leave some portion of their estate to support St. Mary Immaculate Parish are encouraged to have their attorney or estate planning professional include specific language in their will that identifies the charitable beneficiary as St. Mary Immaculate Parish. Donors choosing this philanthropic option are encouraged to notify the Pastor or the business office of their intention so that their generosity may be acknowledged.

Eucharistic Adoration at SMIP

This year's Feast of Corpus Christi also marked the 17th anniversary of our Eucharistic Adoration Ministry, where more than 100,000 hours of prayer have been offered since 2002. Pope Francis stated that Eucharistic Adoration is "the secret to knowing the love of Jesus Christ."

The SMIP Adoration Chapel is open with exposition continuously from 7 p.m. Sundays through 9 p.m. Fridays, which is possible due to the volunteers who come for regular weekly Holy Hours. There are currently a number of open hours at various times of the day and night needing a regular adorer—substitute volunteers are always appreciated, too, since the ministry finds a substitute for you whenever you can't make it. 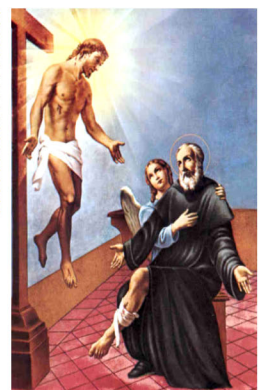
