Monday, May 3 - DAY 1 - DEPART

USA - Today, we depart Chicago to connect with our overnight flight to Warsaw. We enjoy in-flight movies, dinner, and breakfast while aloft.

Tuesday, May 4 - Day 2 - WARSAW -

We arrive in the afternoon at Chopin International Airport, Warsaw. After clearing arrival formalities, we board our motor coach and begin our orientation tour of Warsaw. At the end of the orientation tour we attend Mass at St. Jacob's Church. This is where Jesus said to Saint Faustina: "it's here I called you, and not elsewhere." Early evening check-in at our hotel in Warsaw. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Warsaw.

Wednesday, May 5 - DAY 3 – WARSAW/NIAPOKALANOW/WARSAW

W – Today, after breakfast we start with a sightseeing tour of Warsaw, including a drive through the city center, passing the Warsaw Uprising Museum, the former Ghetto area with the Memorial of the Ghetto Heroes, the Memorial of the Warsaw Uprising, the Royal Route, and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Following a break for lunch on our own in the city center, we drive to Niapokalanow, home of the monastery built by St. Maximilian Kolbe. We celebrate our Mass here. While there we also visit the shrine of Our Mary Immaculate, which houses an incredible adoration chapel which claims to be the most viewed perpetual adoration on the internet! This day we will enjoy the unique opportunity to have dinner at a private home of a Polish family with a Polish folklore show. We return to our hotel in Warsaw for overnight.

**Thursday, May 6 - DAY 4 – WARSAW/
GLOGOWIEC/LODZ** – This morning after breakfast is free for rest, prayer or

exploring Warsaw on our own. After lunch, we regather as a group to drive to Glogowiec, the birthplace of St. Faustina, where Jesus appeared to her in 1931 and requested she paint the picture of "His Divine Mercy". We celebrate our Mass at the parish church of Faustina in Swinice Warckie and her family home in Glogowiec. We then continue to the town of Lodz for dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Friday, May 7 DAY 5 – LODZ/ CZESTOCHOWA/AUSCHWITZ/

KRAKOW – Today after breakfast, we board our motor coach for a two-hour ride to Czestochowa where we make our way to the monastery complex of Jasna Gora to visit this famous Marian Shrine. Jasna Gora consists of a Gothic/Baroque style church, a Baroque monastery and fortress. This is where the miraculous icon of Our Lady of Czestochowa, "The Black Madonna," has been preserved and is often exposed. We tour this shrine and celebrate Mass while there. We break for lunch on our own before continuing with our visit to Auschwitz/Birkenau, site of one of the most infamous death camps, where 1.5 million Jews died at the hands of the Nazis during WWII. We stop at the solemn Martyrdom Museum, as well as the cell of St. Maximilian Kolbe, which Pope St. John Paul II visited in June 1979 on his first visit to Poland after being named Pope. We continue to Krakow for dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Saturday, May 8 - DAY 6 - KRAKOW "THE POLISH ROME"/WIELICZKA/

KRAKOW – This morning after breakfast, we visit the Church of St. Florian, where Pope St. John Paul II served as a curate, and where he lived while serving as the University chaplain. (Pending our actual Mass schedule, we celebrate Mass while there if our Mass at the Salt Mines cannot be scheduled). Afterwards, we meet our local guide and begin our



sightseeing tour. Our first stop is the courtyard of 16th century Royal Castle, and Wawel Cathedral, where generations of Polish Kings are buried. We also visit Kazimierz, an old Jewish city with medieval roots which has preserved according to the original town plan. We then take a walking tour of the Old Town, visiting some of the treasures of this wonderful old city. We view the Town Hall Tower and the Cloth Hall, located on the same site since the 14th century, the 15th century Collegium Maius in the oldest university area and St. Mary's Church. There, we enjoy the ancient tradition of the "Hejnal" or bugle call from the Tower, which warned residents of the coming of an enemy. This afternoon, following lunch on our own, we ride to Wieliczka, famous for its salt mines, which have been in operation for over seven centuries! We visit the upper levels of the mine, and view chapels with altar pieces and statutes all hand carved by devout Polish miners from the same salt. We celebrate Mass while there if possible. We return to Krakow for dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Sunday, May 9 - DAY 7 – KRAKOW/ WADOWICE/KALWARIA/KRAKOW

– Today after breakfast, we depart Krakow and travel to Wadowice, the birthplace of Pope St. John Paul II. En route, we stop by the Kalwaria Zebrzydowska Benedictine Monastery where the Holy Father often prayed and walked the Stations of the Cross. We take time for prayer here in this meditative place. We continue to Wadowice where we have lunch on our own. and afterwards, we visit the museum in his small family home. Afterwards, we celebrate Mass in the parish church where the Holy Father was baptized before returning to Krakow for dinner at one of Krakow Old Town restaurants, including a Polish folklore show and the Klezmer live concert during dinner. We then we return to our hotel for overnight.

Monday, May 10 - DAY 8 – KRAKOW/ LAGIEWNIKI/DIVINE MERCY/ PRAGUE -- This morning after breakfast we visit the newly built Basilica of the Divine Mercy, the home of St. Sister Faustina's tomb. We celebrate our Mass here. We also visit the convent and spend

some time with the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy. We enjoy lunch on our own before we travel to Prague where we enjoy dinner and overnight in our hotel.

Tuesday, May 11 - DAY 9 – PRAGUE – Today after breakfast, we begin our tour of Prague at Castle Hill and visit St. Vitus Cathedral, Wladislav Hall and Golden Lane. We will visit the famous Infant Jesus of Prague at the Church of Our Lady of Victory, where we will celebrate Mass. After lunch on our own, we tour Prague this afternoon with time at the Old Town with Astronomical clock, the Jewish Quarter and the Charles Bridge. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Wednesday, May 12 - DAY 10 - PRAGUE/USA – This morning, we transfer to the airport in Prague as we make our way home with memories for a lifetime.

TOTAL TOUR PRICE: The tour price is based on airfare, cruise, land rates and rates of exchange in effect July 29, 2026. All rates are subject to change without prior notice. Should the rates go up or down, an adjustment would be made prior to departure. Refunds CANNOT be granted for any accommodations, services or events that are not used nor if you deviate from the tour. If fewer than 40 pilgrims participate a price adjustment may be necessary.

PASSPORT AND VISA REQUIREMENTS: A valid passport is required. At the time of printing, U.S. citizens holding valid passports DO NOT REQUIRE visas. Passport MUST be valid until November 12, 2027 or later. Citizens of countries other than U.S. - please contact the consulate of the country or countries being visited to determine visa requirements.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: International flight reservations are being held on LOT Polish Airlines. No stopovers are permitted. Any changes after ticket is issued carries a mandatory charge of \$200. Once the tickets are issued, they are NON-TRANSFERABLE AND NON-REFUNDABLE. Any requests to change a ticket once issued will incur a reissue fee of \$200 plus any fare differential will apply. Cancellation of air seat within 90 days of departure will incur a \$200 penalty.

DOMESTIC AIRFARE: For those who make domestic air arrangements to the originating city of this tour, your tour host and Unitours strongly recommend the purchase of tickets that can be changed without heavy fees and penalties as international flight schedules are always subject to change.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS: Specially selected hotels based on twin occupancy with private bath. Single Room supplement of \$1008 will be charged where requested and available. If you do not have a roommate and Unitours is unable to arrange one, you will be billed for the single room supplement. All singles are subject to availability.

MEALS: Breakfast and Table D' Hote dinners are provided daily except where noted in the itinerary. An extra charge will be made when coffee, tea or other beverages are not included in the menu of the day with the dinner meal.

TIPS AND TAXES: Tips and taxes normally appearing on hotel and restaurant bills as service are included, as are all government and local taxes on hotels and meals, portage of one suitcase per person. International departure taxes of \$131 plus current fuel surcharges of \$450 are included (subject to change). TIPS TO TOUR MANAGER/GUIDES, DRIVERS OR DINING ROOMS STAFF OF \$96 ARE NOT INCLUDED. One average sized suitcase not exceeding 50 lbs total weight and 62 linear inches (height plus width plus depth) is permitted throughout the trip.

DEPOSITS AND CANCELLATIONS: A deposit of \$500 is required to secure reservations. Any balance is to be paid in full no later than 60 days before departure of tour. Final payments received at Unitours after 45 days before departure must include a \$25 late payment fee. (This does not apply for new reservations made after 45 days of departure.) Reservations made within 60 days of departure must include full payment. Amex, Discover, Visa and MasterCard are accepted with signed reservation form. Final payments will be applied to same credit card on final

payment due date. Cancellations made from time of reservation to within 61 days prior to departure - - \$400 administration fee (charged to deposit) plus any air penalties noted above. In the event of a cancellation from 60 to 31 days prior to departure - - \$400 administration fee plus up to 50% of the land cost, plus any air penalties noted above. No refund for cancellations received within 30 days of departure. All cancellation and refund claims must be in writing to Unitours, Inc.

BANK FEE: A fee of \$50 will be charged for any check that is returned to us for insufficient or unavailable funds.

DEVIATIONS: A service charge of \$50 pp will be applied for any deviations made in tour, (where possible), PLUS any additional air or land charges incurred.
