Faith Formation 2026-2027-Registration Packet

Dear St. Patrick Families,

Registration is now open for the 2026-2027 Faith Formation class sessions. Our goal is to continue to provide a family-friendly program for parents and children learning and serving together.

We know research affirms parental guidance and example are the most important influences by far on their children's faith. The best chance of building a life-long faith in children comes from active, involved and believing parents.

Our faith formation sessions are designed to support what parents begin at home by teaching their children about our Catholic faith. Our catechists use developmentally appropriate materials and resources designed to help children learn, understand, grow and mature in their faith. The teaching materials we use are approved for use in Catholic Faith Formation programs in our Diocese.

Our Faith Formation sessions are for those in the following ages:

- **Kindergarten-8th grade**
- **Preparation for the sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion**
- **Preparation for the sacrament of Confirmation**
- **Preparation for those outside the customary age for sacrament**

It is expected that children will attend Faith Formation sessions on a regular basis every year from kindergarten through High School. High School Youth Ministry is on Sunday afternoons, a separate Registration Form is available online or in the Church Office. Every child deserves to grow up rooted in the rich tradition of our faith. Enrolling children in faith formation sessions every year helps to build a strong foundation of understanding, knowledge and love of our faith that helps each child grow into a faith-filled adult.

"Catechesis aims to bring about in the believer an ever more mature faith in Jesus Christ, a deeper knowledge and love of his person and message, and a firm commitment to follow him. The object of catechesis is communion with Jesus Christ. Catechesis leads people to enter the mystery of Christ, to encounter him, and to discover themselves and the meaning of their lives in him."

How to Register

- Parents or guardians must fill out a new registration form to enroll their children **every year**. Forms may be found on our parish website, www.stpatricktampa.org, in the church and in the Parish Office.
- Completed forms may be returned by email to Angy Hayes at faithformation@stpatricktampa.org or sent via U.S. mail to the attention of Angy Hayes 4518 S. Manhattan Ave. Tampa FL 33611

The following documents must be completed and returned with the registration form for children to participate in the St. Patrick faith formation sessions.

- A copy of a child's Baptismal Certificate must be provided for children enrolling for the first time, and for all children preparing for the reception of Holy Communion or Confirmation
- A copy of the child's Baptism and First Communion Certificate for all candidates preparing for the sacrament of Confirmation.
- Completed Registration Form which includes a contact information form and a student medical release form
- In case of divorce and custody agreement- a copy of the most current declaration page from the divorce degree.
- Payment of registration fee/or payment arrangement-see registration fees on the Registration Form. No child will be turned away from enrolling due to inability to pay registration fee. First Holy Communion-customary age 2nd grade

Confirmation- customary age 8th grade

St Patrick Catholic Church in Tampa supports the Sacramental Preparation policies of the Diocese of St. Petersburg. **One year of attending faith formation sessions in a parish program or a Catholic school is required before a child begins a second year of preparation for the sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and Confirmation.**

Sacramental preparation classes require an interview prior to finalizing enrollment and class placement.

As we prepare students for reception of the sacraments, we want to emphasize the importance of regular attendance and active participation in Faith Formation classes, and any additional activities required for their preparation.

For parents with children who wish to receive sacraments but are outside of the customary age and progression for preparing to receive them, we ask that you contact the Faith Formation Director, Angy Hayes, at faithformation@stpatricktampa.org or call (813) 839-5337 ext. 131.

When do Faith Formation Sessions Meet?

- Classroom sessions for kindergarten-grade 8 meet on Sunday mornings from 9:00am-9:50am in the school building
- Sacramental Preparation for children outside customary age and progression- grades 5-8- Wednesday evenings from 6:00-7:15 pm in the school building

Confirmation Preparation

- 8th Grade classroom- dates and times are the same as K-7 with additional sessions, including a full day retreat for the preparation of the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Please mark your calendars and have students plan to attend all sessions and a retreat day- (date and time to be determined)- as part of their sacramental preparation.

There will be a welcome gathering with parents and students on the first day of classes-Sunday 9/13/2025 at 9:00 am in the Social Hall. We will review the school calendar, and our drop-off and pick-up procedure, and answer any questions you may have.

St. Patrick Catholic Church Tampa supports the Sacramental Preparation policies of the Diocese of St. Petersburg. To receive any sacrament a child must be enrolled and attend one full year of faith formation in a parish or Catholic school and may receive their sacraments the second year of attendance.

The following documents must be completed and returned with the registration form to complete the registration process.

- First Reconciliation/First Communion: Baptismal Certificate
- Confirmation: Baptismal certificate and First Communion Certificate
- In case of divorce and custody agreement: A copy of the most current declaration page from the divorce decree
- Payment of registration fee or payment arrangement (Calculate total payment below)

For those seeking First Communion (2nd grade or older): \$135.00 x _____ = _____

For those seeking Confirmation (8th grade or older): \$135.00 x _____ = _____
