1st Reading - Zechariah 9:9-10

The prophet invites the people of Zion to rejoice as their gentle savior comes among them riding a colt.

Banishing war, the savior will proclaim peace to the nations and his dominion will reach the ends of the earth.

Psalm - 145:1-2, 8-11, 13-14

"I will praise your name for ever, my king and my God."

We give glory to God for his merciful and gracious works that bless us.

2nd Reading - Romans 8:9, 11-13

As the Spirit of God dwells in us we are united to Christ and renewed by his resurrection.

We no longer live according to the flesh, which leads to death, but in the Spirit that brings us life.

Gospel - Matthew 11:25-30

Jesus offers a prayer of praise to the Father for all that has been accomplished by his gracious will.

The Lord then invites all who labor and are weary to come to him and rest.

SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL

July 4th - Feast of St. Pier Giorgio Frassati

St. Pier Giorgio Frassati was born in 1901 in Italy. From the time he was twelve until his death at twenty-four Pier Giorgio received Holy Communion daily. At 17, he joined the Society of St. Vincent de Paul and committed himself to serving the poor. Pier Giorgio said: "Jesus visits me every morning in Holy Communion. I repay him with my poor means, visiting the poor." When asked how he could stand the bad odors and dirt of the poor, he answered: "Don't forget that even if the house you visit is very dirty, there you may find Jesus." The last months of his life were filled with suffering; he contracted poliomyelitis and became paralyzed. When he died hundreds of unknown faces who loved this generous young man came to view his body. He was canonized a saint in September of 2025 by Pope Leo XIV.
