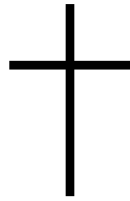

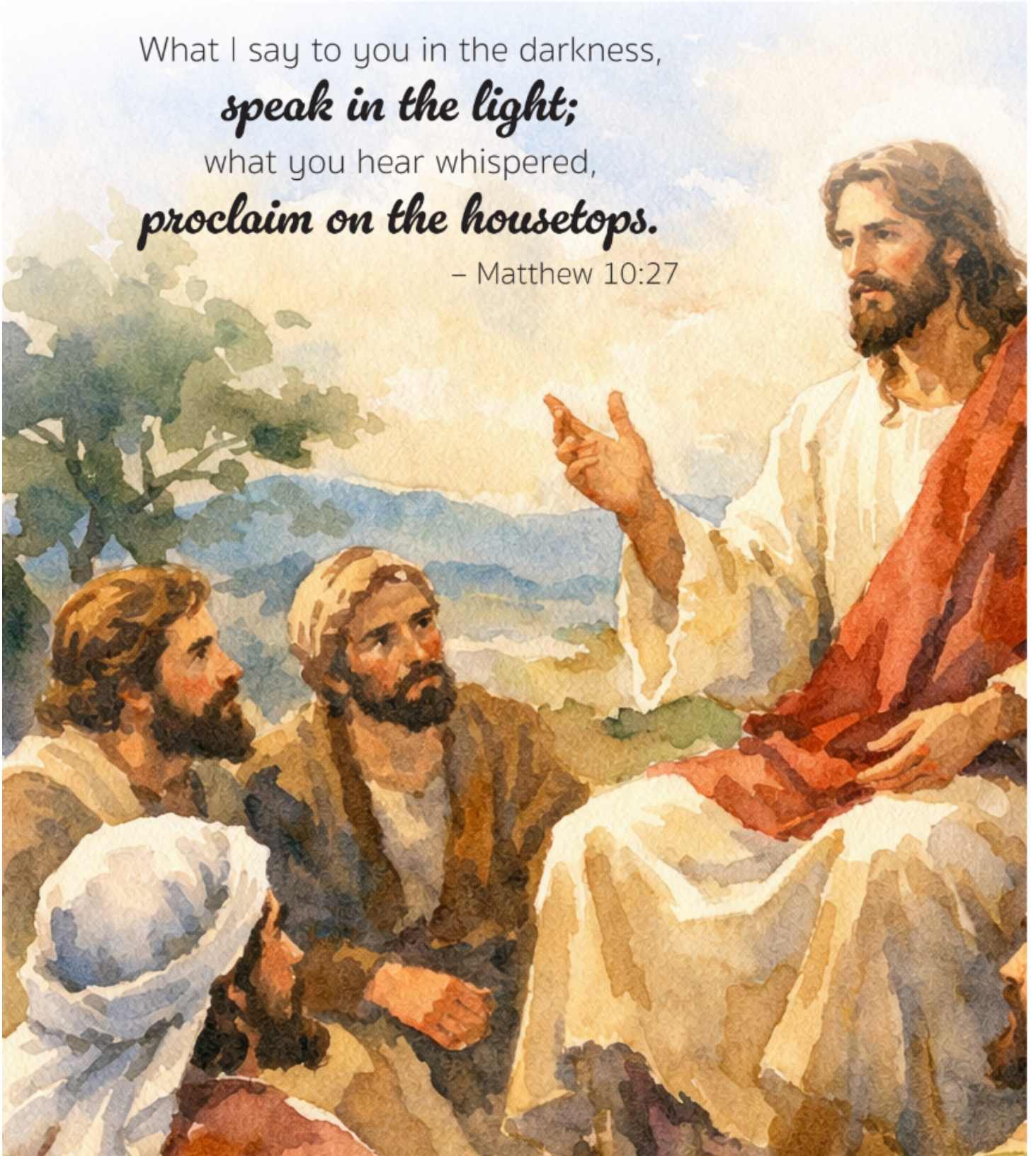

Father's Day and Our Father in Heaven

Heavenly Father Love

Dear Friends:

This weekend, as we celebrate Father's Day, the Scriptures direct our attention to a truth that lies at the very heart of the Christian faith: **God is our Father.** Jesus spoke of God as Father so naturally and so often that we can sometimes miss how remarkable that is.

Throughout the Gospels, He invites us into His own relationship with the Father. He teaches us to pray, "Our Father." He assures us that the Father knows what we need before we ask. He reminds us that the Father watches over us with a love greater than we can imagine.

Every earthly father, at his best, is meant to be a reflection of that heavenly reality. A good father protects. He provides. He teaches. He sacrifices. He encourages. He corrects when necessary. He helps his children discover who they are and who they are called to become. In doing so, he gives us a glimpse—however imperfect—of the love of our Father in heaven.

Of course, human fathers are not perfect. Some of us were blessed with extraordinary fathers. Others experienced fathers who struggled, were absent, or who failed to provide the love they longed for. **Father's Day can therefore be a joyful celebration for some and a difficult day for others.**

The good news of the Gospel is that no matter what our earthly experience has been, we all have a perfect Father in heaven. His love never wavers. His patience never runs out. His mercy is never exhausted. He knows us completely and loves us completely.

On this Father's Day, I encourage you to pray for all fathers: fathers who are actively raising children, grandfathers who continue to guide their families, fathers who have lost children, fathers who carry heavy burdens, and fathers who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith.

I also encourage fathers to remember the immense dignity of their vocation. The world needs good fathers. Families need good fathers. The Church needs good fathers. Your presence, your example, your prayers, and your sacrifices matter more than you may ever know.

Finally, let us thank God for the gift of His fatherly love. Every good thing we receive ultimately comes from Him. May all fathers find their strength in Him, and may all of us grow in trust and confidence as beloved sons and daughters of our Father in heaven.

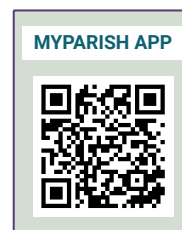

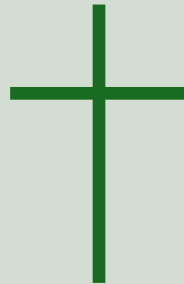
