“AMEN!” WHAT DOES THAT WORD MEAN? It means: “Yes, I believe.” Those simple words are spoken so often during the Holy Mass, but perhaps nowhere are they more important than when we come forward to receive the Holy Eucharist. As the minister says, “The Body of Christ,” we respond with conviction and faith: “Amen.” In that moment, we are professing: “Yes, I believe this is truly the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, our Lord and our God.” This Sunday, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ -- Corpus Christi Sunday. It is a day set aside to rejoice in the greatest gift Jesus left to His Church: Himself in the Holy Eucharist. The Eucharist is not merely a symbol or a reminder, but the Real Presence of Christ. At every Mass, heaven touches earth as Christ becomes truly present upon our altar and gives Himself to us as spiritual food.

SAINT CARLO ACUTIS, CANONIZED BY POPE LEO ON SEPTEMBER 7, 2025, is a powerful witness to this truth for our time. He devoted his short life to documenting Eucharistic miracles from around the world, helping others to recognize the consistent and extraordinary ways God has strengthened belief in the Real Presence throughout history. Yet he would always remind us that the greatest miracle is not found in extraordinary signs, but in the quiet, daily miracle that takes place at every Mass when bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.


OUR EUCHARISTIC ADORATION HOURS also offer a beautiful opportunity to deepen our love for the Lord truly present in the Blessed Sacrament. Time spent before Jesus in the Eucharist strengthens faith, renews hearts, and draws us into a deeper relationship with Christ who remains with His Church always.

THIS FRIDAY, WE ALSO CELEBRATE THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS. Throughout this week we continue praying our novena in preparation for the consecration of our nation to the Sacred Heart, asking the Lord to pour out His mercy, healing, and love upon our country. In a world marked by division and uncertainty, we turn with confidence to the Heart of Jesus — a Heart burning with love for every person.

AS WE ENTER THE MONTH OF JUNE, many begin to think about summer plans, travel, and vacations. These are good and healthy gifts of rest and renewal. Yet even as we travel, God never takes a vacation from us. We are invited to bring Him with us — in prayer, in Sunday Mass, and in moments of quiet gratitude wherever we go.

And so, every time we say “Amen,” may it not be routine, but a true act of faith: “Yes, Lord, I believe.”

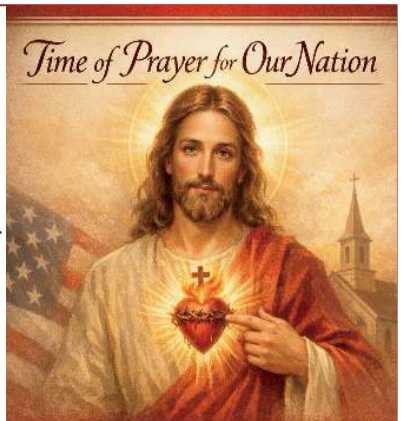
MEN’S BOOK STUDY – THE POWER OF THE ROSARY
