PARISH TRANSITION UPDATE

As we continue preparing for the official launch of St. Joan of Arc Catholic Parish on July 1, transition planning remains actively underway behind the scenes. Teams from both campuses continue meeting regularly to coordinate finances, communications, ministries, records, operations, and parish life so that this transition is as smooth and seamless as possible for everyone involved.

Over the coming weeks, we will begin sharing more detailed information about practical changes connected to the merger, including parish giving, online donations, banking transitions, communication systems, and other administrative updates. For now, however, everything remains exactly the same. Please continue writing checks and making contributions just as you currently do through your existing parish. No action is needed yet.

Beginning July 1, contributions may then be made directly to St. Joan of Arc Parish. Additional information regarding online giving, ACH/direct withdrawal, and updated giving platforms will be communicated in June.

As we move into this exciting new chapter together, we also invite parishioners to prayerfully reflect on stewardship and financial support of the mission of the Church. Bringing two parish communities together creates tremendous opportunities for ministry, evangelization, Catholic education, and long-term stability for the future. Your continued generosity and sacrificial support will play an important role in helping build a strong and vibrant future for St. Joan of Arc Parish.

We have also received several questions regarding sacramental and parish records. Per the official diocesan decree establishing the new parish, the permanent parish records for St. Joan of Arc Parish will be housed at the St. John Vianney Catholic Church campus. However, parishioners may continue to contact either campus office for assistance with records, certificates, or parish needs. Our staff is committed to making this process easy and helpful for everyone.

This weekend, the initial members of the new St. Joan of Arc Parish Council will be selected as part of the transition process. Each current parish council has been asked to appoint members to help form the new unified council, providing leadership continuity and representation from both parish communities. Three members from each campus will be added. An additional three members will also be drawn from volunteers at the Saturday evening mass this weekend. Please keep these parish leaders in your prayers as they help guide this important new chapter in the life of our parish.

While July 1 is the official launch date for the new parish, not every transition item will happen overnight. Some systems and processes will be ready immediately, while others will continue developing throughout the summer and, in some cases, through the remainder of the calendar year. This will naturally be a time of adjustment as we learn, refine, and build together.

At the same time, our hope is that much of parish life will continue to feel very familiar. Masses, ministries, parish activities, friendships, and the daily rhythm of parish life will continue. There may occasionally be moments of confusion or small bumps along the way, but please know that everyone involved is working hard to make this transition thoughtful, organized, and pastoral. Most importantly, we are confident that together, with patience, communication, and grace, everything will come together well in the end.

Thank you for your continued patience, prayers, and support during this historic transition. The spirit of collaboration and hope surrounding this new chapter has already been incredibly encouraging.

MELISSA STEINKE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2026-27 YEAR IN REVIEW

We are incredibly grateful to all who have helped make Year Two of the Melissa Steinke Scholarship Program a tremendous success.

A heartfelt thank you goes to our generous donors, the Melissa Steinke Scholarship Committee and Subcommittee, *Parish Neighbors*, *The Catholic Messenger*, and *Relevant Radio*, Fr. Rich, the St. Joan of Arc Foundation, the trustees of St. John Vianney and Our Lady of Lourdes, and the combined finance council and business offices of SJV and OLOL, and all who offered support, ideas, and prayers.

Our goal for the **2026-27 school year** was to award **\$75,000 in scholarships**. Thanks to your generosity, we exceeded that goal by more than \$5,500, awarding **\$80,503** in school scholarships to St. Joan of Arc Catholic School families.

- Total scholarship dollars awarded: \$80,503
- Total scholarship dollars requested: \$96,500
- Number of scholarships awarded (families): 36
- Number of scholarship applications received: 40
- Number of students benefitting from scholarship funds: 62

Looking ahead, our goal for the **2027-28 school year** is to award **at least \$100,000 in scholarships**. Donations are being accepted through **December 1, 2026**.

The Year Three (2027-28) will open **October 1, 2026**, and close **January 11, 2027**. Scholarships will be awarded **February 8, 2027**.
