## PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

**AS WE CELEBRATE THE SOLEMNITY OF THE HOLY TRINITY**, we are reminded that unity does not erase identity. The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are distinct Persons, yet perfectly united in love and mission. In a similar way, our parish communities continue to walk together in faith, each with its own history, gifts, and traditions, while growing more deeply united in purpose.

Throughout the summer, we will continue prayerfully exploring how certain ministries and parish activities may gradually find their home at St. Joan of Arc Parish-St. John Vianney, while also continuing to support and sustain the life and vitality of St Joan of Arc Parish-Our Lady of Lourdes. (That feels strange to write that new name!) Please know that, at this time, there are no immediate plans to close Our Lady of Lourdes, and we intend to keep the parish offices open there as long as they are needed. Rather than seeing this as an ending, I pray we can view it as an opportunity to strengthen our shared mission, use our resources wisely, and continue building vibrant Catholic communities rooted in faith, unity, and service to one another. As always, these conversations and decisions will unfold prayerfully, carefully, and with deep gratitude for the people and history that have shaped each of our parishes.

Today's Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity stands at the very heart of our Catholic faith. We believe in one God who has revealed Himself as three Divine Persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. While this mystery can never be fully understood by the human mind, it can be known through faith and experienced through love. The Trinity reminds us that God is not solitude, but perfect communion — a communion of love into which we ourselves are invited. Every time we make the Sign of the Cross, celebrate the Mass, or gather as the Church, we are drawn more deeply into the life and unity of the Holy Trinity.

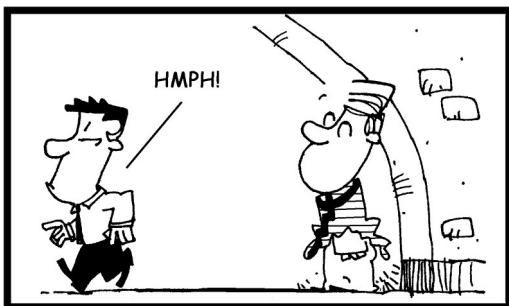
