PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

OVER THE PAST SEVERAL WEEKS, the Church has led us through some of the most beautiful celebrations of our liturgical year. We rejoiced in the fifty days of Easter, celebrated the Ascension of our Lord, welcomed anew the gift of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, honored the Most Holy Trinity, celebrated the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, and just this past Friday, reflected on the immeasurable love of Christ in the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Now we return to what the Church calls *Ordinary Time*. Yet, as I often remind people, there is nothing ordinary about Ordinary Time. This season, which stretches until Advent, is a time when we walk closely with Jesus, listening to His teachings, learning from His example, and growing as His disciples. While special feast days will continue to mark our calendar, these coming months invite us to deepen our daily relationship with Christ and allow His Gospel to shape our lives.

This Sunday's Gospel presents us with a powerful image. Jesus looks upon the crowds and says, "The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few." He sees countless hearts longing for hope, mercy, and God's grace. Then He tells His disciples to pray for laborers and immediately sends them out into the mission field. It is a reminder that God often answers our prayers by inviting us to become part of the answer.



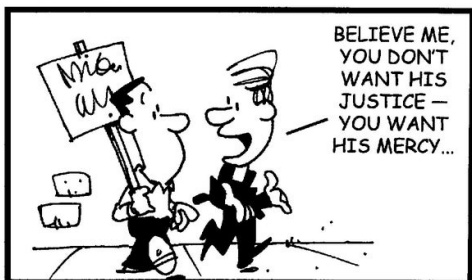
WE HAVE REASON TO BE GRATEFUL AND HOPEFUL in our own Diocese of Davenport. This past weekend, we celebrated the priestly ordination of Alfonso Pizano. What a tremendous blessing for our diocesan family! Even more encouraging is the news from our Vocations Office that next fall, we expect to have eighteen seminarians studying for the Diocese of Davenport, twice the number we currently have. There are also several more young men participating in discernment groups as they continue to listen for God's call. Every weekend we pray for vocations. Families continue to welcome the Vocations Chalice into their homes, praying intentionally for priests, deacons, and religious vocations. God is listening. God is working. God is raising up laborers for His harvest. *(If you would like to pray in your home with the Vocations Chalice for a week, please sign up in the binder purple binder, on the stand next to the vocations table in the gathering space.)*

As we pray for priests, we must also pray for deacons. Our diocese has a great need for faithful men who are willing to serve Christ and His Church through the permanent diaconate. If you have ever felt the Lord stirring your heart toward this ministry, I encourage you to explore that possibility. Introductory sessions will be offered this fall as preparation for the next formation program. If you would like more information, please speak with one of our deacons or contact me. We would be happy to walk with you as you discern God's call.



It is hard to believe we are already well into June. May the Sacred Heart of Jesus watch over you and your loved ones, and may we continue together to pray for laborers for the harvest. Have a blessed week! **~Fr. Rich**

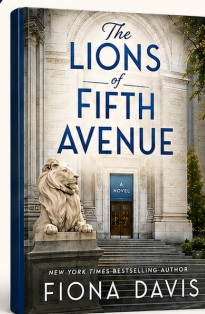
