THREE SIMPLE WORDS FROM JESUS IN THIS SUNDAY'S GOSPEL: "Do not fear." We hear those words repeatedly throughout Sacred Scripture because God knows how easily fear can take hold of our hearts. 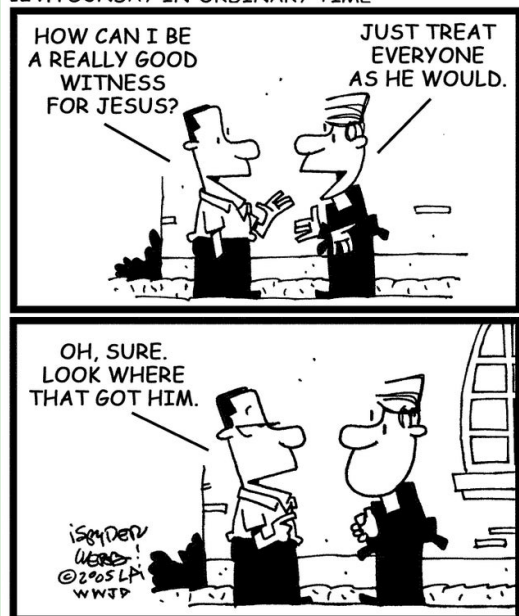

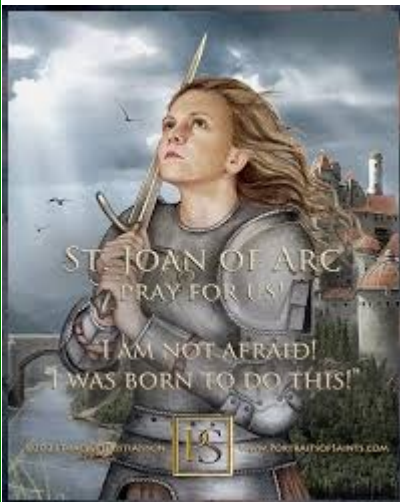
