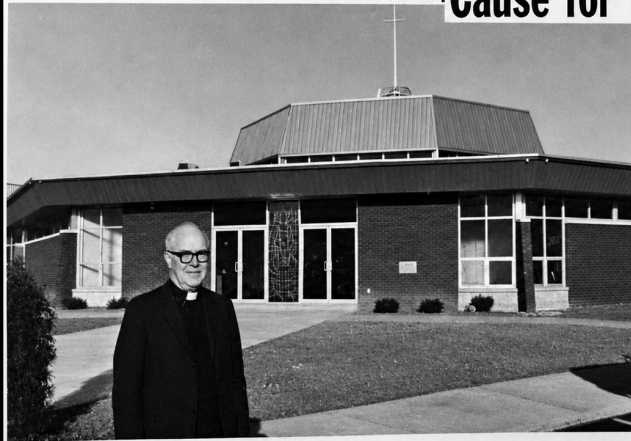

Cause for Thanks—Church Is Ready

Members of St. John Vianney Catholic Church will have special reason to feel thankful this Thanksgiving.

Their new church building at 18th and Tanglefoot Lane is nearly enough completed to be put into use.

Both the first church service and the first event in the parish hall will be held within the next seven days.

Rev. John McGrath will celebrate the first Mass in the new building at 9 a.m. Thanksgiving Day. The pews will not be in place until next week, but folding chairs are being provided to use in the meantime.

The first function to be held in the parish hall will be a Christmas Bazaar next Wednesday, Dec. 3, from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m.

Among the items to be sold will be toys and jewelry, ornamental Christmas trees, paintings, plaques, banners, wreaths,

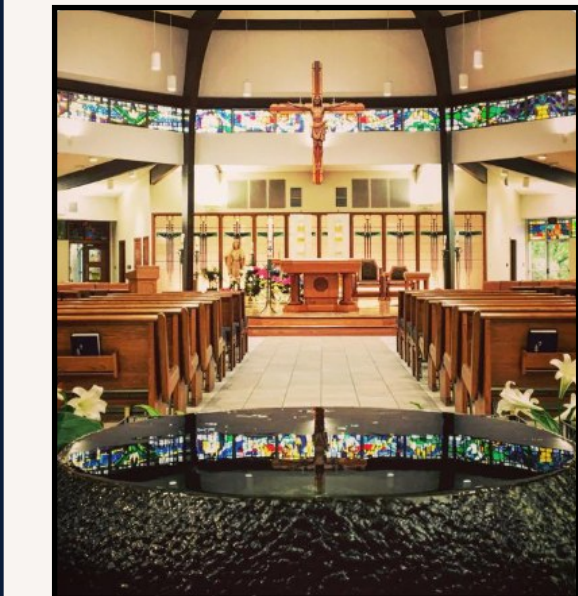
topiary trees, tree ornaments and knit items.

Coffee and doughnuts will be available and there will be a bake sale.

The bazaar is being sponsored by the women of the parish. The general chairman is Mrs. Kenneth Dichiser. Her co-chairmen are Mrs. Rod Rabens and Mrs. Michael Galligan.

Heading other committees are: Finance, Mrs. Walter Brehmer; publicity, Mrs. Paul DeCoster and Mrs. Eugene Weis; set-up and pricing, Mrs. Patrick McCormick; selling, Mrs. Homer Elkin and Mrs. Joseph Hetzel; and cleanup, Mrs. Thomas Bartelli.

In addition to the parish hall and the church proper, the new building includes offices for the parish priest and the religious education department, the rectory, and a social hall.

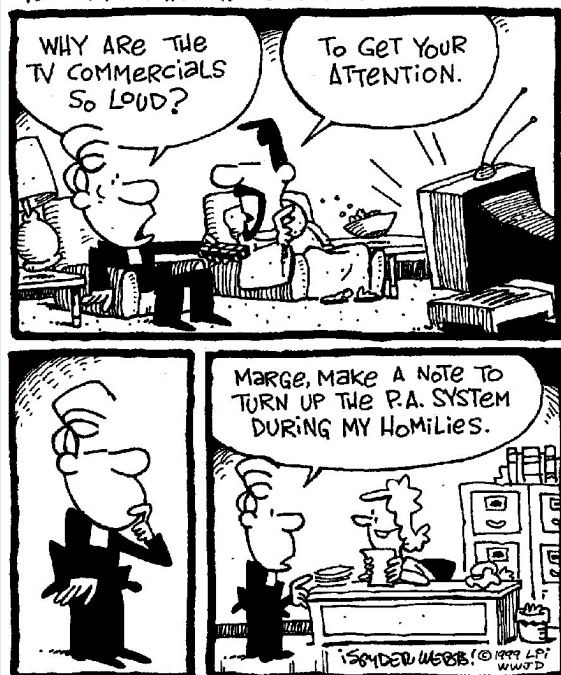

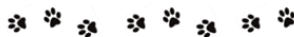
May this summer be a season of renewal, and may the Lord bless our journey as we prepare to become St. Joan of Arc Parish—a community united in faith, hope, and love.

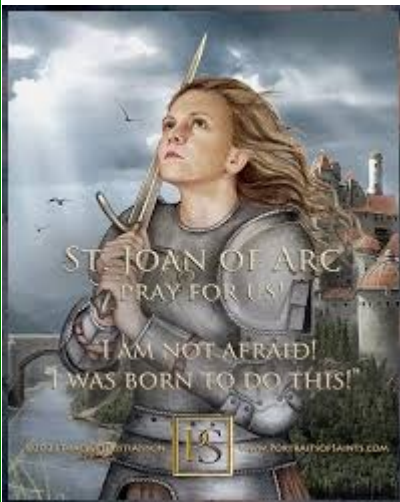

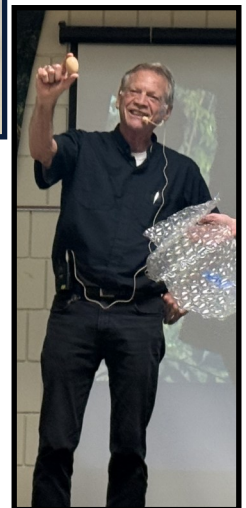
